

# Easy come, easy go

In Buddies Café, Danny Chan demonstrates how to turn an obstacle into inspiration

ong Kongers are no strangers to *cha chaan tengs* ('tea houses'), but in Tung
Chung, Buddies Café is moving the
design goalposts with a new vocabulary
defining the eatery's space.

Beige Design's Danny Chan took on and delivered the project within two months, thanks to a simple brief and a smooth rollout of the entire endeavour.

A wealth of experience in fast-food restaurant design helped Chan gain the trust of his client. Working within a constrained timeframe, however, became the guiding light to Chan's approach: "I didn't have the luxury of time to let my thoughts flow, so what I did was collect whatever ideas the site had to offer," he says.

A huge hexagonal column in the middle of the restaurant posed his first challenge, as it took up significant space and effectively split the area into two. Chan, however, took it in his stride. "If you study chemistry, you'd know the term 'hexagon' can refer to chemical bonds. As the name of the restaurant is 'Buddies', I linked these two elements to form the direction of the design," he explains.

The hexagon, thus, became the central design feature of Buddies Café: from mirrors, wooden honeycomb feature walls, ceiling and floors to the cash counter and pendant lights covered in hexagonal wire casing, all are inspired by the geometric form.


"The client wanted a flexible seating area to cater for more people, so I created honeycombshaped tables which can be used individually or in combination to fit smaller or larger groups," Chan says.

Even the window in front of the cafeteria-style kitchen's roast meat area is hexagonal. "It was originally a rectangular glass window; I changed it in order to create a sense of cohesiveness," says the designer.

Once the physical challenges of the design were overcome, Chan's next task was to create a modern, youthful interior without losing the lively, communal feel of a traditional *cha chaan teng*. Colours selected were white, brown and black, and he created cleverly-concealed storage space under booths and tables – common practice in local tea houses.

Chan's one regret was that the budget did not stretch to accommodate a lighting consultancy. "I believe the lighting effects, especially those along the feature walls, could have been better," he says.

Regardless, Buddies Café stands as testament to his determination to find inspiration where others might only see obstacles.

## 設計速成法

Danny Chan將Buddies Café格局上的缺憾巧妙化成創作的靈感

港人無一不認識茶餐廳文化,但是位於東涌的 Buddies Café就為本地的茶餐廳貫注全新的演 繹方法。

由Beige Design的Danny Chan親自操刀,在短短 的兩個月內便把設計完成,全賴直截了當的設計委託 及發展順暢的設計過程。

Danny具豐富的連鎖式快餐店的設計經驗,因此客 戶也對他有十足的信心。短速的完成時間並不造成限 制,反而是設計的明燈指引。他說:「沒有充裕的時 間反而令我思路更清晰,我決定就地取材,讓快餐店 的格局成為我的指引。」

快餐店中央的六角形柱是Danny要面對的第一個 設計挑戰。巨型的柱子把快餐店分成兩邊,Danny便 充分利用了這個特點。他解釋:「要是你有讀過化學 科的話,會明白六角形其實是指一化學鍵。既然快餐 店叫Buddies(好朋友),我便結合這兩個元素成為我 的空間主題。」

毫無疑問,六角形便成了Buddies Café的設計主 調,從壁鏡、木製蜂巢形特色牆、天花及地板,以至

Danny說:「客戶要求靈活的座位安排,能隨時改 動,好讓更多的顧客同時享用。於是我便把餐桌設計 成蜂巢形,可照顧三數個或一大班顧客的需要。」

就算是自助式的燒味部,窗子也是六角形的,他 續說:「本來這是一隻長方形的窗子,為了統一的原 故,都改裝成六角形。」

當解決了格局上的阻礙後,Danny的下一個任務是 為快餐店創造活力的室內氣氛,同時保留茶餐廳的傳 統特色。於是,他透過簡單的黑白啡三色去達成這個 目標,再在卡位的桌子上加設常見於茶餐廳內貯存餐 具的抽屜。

可是,Danny認為唯一美中不足之處,是礙於資金 有限,未能為項目聘請燈光顧問,他說:「我認為那 的視覺效果。」

別人視作難題,Danny卻能夠轉化成設計靈感, 聰明的做法值得讚賞。

### Go toward the light 光合作用

Using a clever lighting strategy in its newest outlets in the UK, Pizza Express has refreshed its look with a minimum of fuss

英國連鎖薄餅店Pizza Express最近為兩間新店 引入新燈光設計系統,以合符經濟效益的方針, 達成理想的燈光效果

Commissioned by Pizza Express UK, Mindseye Lighting has begun a review of the restaurant chain's lighting strategy in its outlets, beginning in Solihull and Gloucester Quays.

With a new zoning strategy within the restaurants, including fast dining at the restaurant entrance, a 'family zone' overlooking the Pizzaiola and a 'couples zone' in the quieter areas, the new concept was to create different pools of light with varying intensity for the different zones.

All this was achieved using existing light fittings, but with different reflectors and lenses and only using two lamp types.

The remainder of the scheme focused on accentuating feature areas - the wine and glass displays and banquette seat lighting to create additional atmosphere and interest in the surroundings

新的分區格局把餐廳劃分為三大區域,快餐部 設於入口處;面向薄餅烹焗區,是專門供一家大小 共聚的地方。至於兩口子可以到情侶廳,環境較為 安靜。燈光明暗視乎不同分區的需要來配合。

設計師沿用現成的燈光組合,把不同的反光 片及鏡片放在限定的兩種燈具內,便能製造理想 的效果。

為了突出陳設酒及酒杯,以及宴會廳的區 域,設計師更刻意加強四周的燈光氣氛。
